### DIFFERENT WAYS TO TRADE FOREX

There are four different ways to trade Forex, we will only be focusing on one of them. The four methodsare *Spot Market, Futures, Options, and Exchange-traded Funds*.

#### **SPOT MARKET**

In the spot market, currencies are traded immediately or "on the spot" using the current market price. The simplicity, liquidity, tight spreads, and 24 hours a day operation make this the most popular of the four methods. You can start with tiny accounts of \$25 (not recommended but possible) up to several million-dollar accounts. This is the market that we will focus on.

#### **FUTURES**

Futures are contracts to buy or sell a certain asset at a specified price on a future date. Forex futureswere first created in 1972 by Chicago Mercantile Exchange. Since futures contracts are standardized and traded through a centralized exchange, the market is very transparent and well-regulated.

#### **OPTIONS**

An "option" is a financial instrument that gives the buyer the right or the option (with no obligation) tobuy or sell an asset at a specified price on the option's expiration date. If a trader "sold" an option, thenhe or she would be obliged to buy or sell an asset at a specific price on the expiration date.

#### **EXCHANGE-TRADED FUNDS**

An ETF could contain a set of stocks with currencies, allowing the trader to diversify with variousdifferent assets. They can be traded like stocks through an exchange. The market is not open 24 hours, however, and since they contain stocks they are subject to trading commissions and other transaction costs.


